

# 2016-2017 UCLA Faculty Career Development Award for Acting Professors

## Career Development Award Program

The Faculty Career Development Awards for AY'16 -'17 responds to the needs of non-tenured ladder faculty members for support for scholarship and creative activities necessary for promotion to tenure. Special consideration will be given to nontenured ladder faculty who have helped build an equal learning environment and whose research or creative activities further inclusive excellence. Only non-tenured ladder faculty members, who have held the Acting Professor title for *at least* one academic year, may apply. ### Awards are made in the form of:

- One-Ninth (summer salary)
- Research funds (\$5,000-\$10,000)

#### **Rules & Eligibility**

- Applications are invited from acting professors in the regular rank professorial series, with the exception of individuals for whom AY'16-'17 will be his or her final year as acting professor because of promotion, nonreappointment, or resignation.
- Individuals with fiscal-year appointments are not eligible for summer salary.
- Prior recipients may apply; however priority will normally be given to those who have not had previous awards.

## How to Apply

Submit the following to Dean:

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Two to three page proposal, including:
  - Career plans and progress.
  - Detailed description of project to be undertaken during the award period.
  - Statement of whether and how the research enhances diversity efforts.
- 3. Curriculum Vitae.

#### **Review Process**

The review process for all applications includes:

Applicants submit application materials to the Dean.

- 1. The Dean will forward all application materials to the office for Equity, Diversity and Inclusion with an overall priority listing and comments on each application.
- 2. A campus-wide faculty committee will be appointed to review applications and make recommendations to the Chancellor.
- 3. Notification letters will be sent to all applicants in May 2016.
